Since 2014, Yoel Finkelman has been **Curator of the Judaica Collection** at **The National Library of Israel**, the largest collection of Judaica books, print materials, and archives in the world. Prior to this, Yoel was a **lecturer** in the Interdisciplinary Graduate Program in Contemporary Jewry and in the Israel Experience program for foreign students at **Bar Ilan University**, Ramat Gan. His topics included Jewish education since the 2nd half of the 20th century and the history of Zionist thought. From 1996 – 2014, Yoel taught Talmud and Jewish thought in a yearlong seminary program of advanced Jewish studies for post-high school women at **Midreshet Lindenbaum** in Jerusalem. Yoel has published one book, *Strictly Kosher Reading: Popular Literature and the Condition of Contemporary Orthodoxy*, and numerous pamphlets and articles, including *Thought and Practice: The Sources of Faith and the Study of Jewish Thought Among Israeli Religious-Zionist Youth*, *Teaching Toward Tomorrow: An Agenda for Orthodox Education in the United States*, and *Between Right and Left in Religious-Zionism*.
